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
INTRODUCTION

Accessibility

Disabled Parking and Wheelchair Access

We have disabled parking spaces adjacent to the Museum entrance and all parts of the Museum are fully wheelchair accessible. We also have wheelchairs that can be borrowed by visitors if required. Part of the Museum is on the first floor and access to this area can be gained using our lift.

Toilets

The Museum has two accessible toilets, one in Reception and one in the Hayward Hall.

Guide dogs

Guide dogs registered with the International Guide Dog Federation (IGDF) and Assistance Dogs UK (see below) are welcome in the Museum and water can be provided as required.

Assistance dogs

We understand that some visitors to the Museum will require the support of an assistance or emotional support dog and we are happy to admit appropriately trained dogs into the Museum. Assistance dogs registered with Assistance Dogs International (ADI) or Assistance Dogs UK (ADUK) are always welcome if visitors can show Museum staff an appropriate ID book.

Optional Extras

Guided Tours

We have a team of experienced Tour Guides who can take groups around the Museum. Visitors enjoy their personal anecdotes and knowledge of our exhibits and all agree that this enhances a visit to the Museum. We can arrange tours for corporate bookings specific to your requirements. Please note, tours are a minimum of 90 minutes and have a maximum of 12 per group, the cost is £30 per Guide. These must be booked in advance.

Terms and Conditions

Hire of Museum

The Museum is available for hire between the hours of 8.30am and Midnight . Monday to Sunday. Please ensure that the time you book at the Museum is adequate for all your preparations, the event itself and clearing up afterwards. The Hirer shall not sublet the premises or any part thereof. The Museum will only be used for the event detailed on the booking form. The Hirer will leave the premises in a clean and tidy state.

Health and Safety

All electrical equipment brought into the Museum must have a current Portable Appliance Test certificate. Hirers must take reasonable care for their own health and safety, and for the health and safety of others who may be affected by their actions. All doors directly leading outside are emergency exits and must be kept clear at all times. Smoking and the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted inside the Museum, and only in the designated areas outside.

Fire

The Hirer shall observe all fire regulations applicable to the holding of the relevant event, and shall comply with any instructions from the Museum. It is the responsibility of the Hirer to ensure that in the event of the evacuation of the premises, all persons known to be present are ushered to the fire assembly point at the bottom of the Museum car park.

DBS Checks

DBS checks are carried out on certain members of the Museum staff, dependent on their job role.

First Aid

All Museum staff are first aid trained. Any incidents that occur must be reported to a member of the Museum staff as soon as possible and no later 24 hours after the incident.

Insurance

The Museum's insurance policy covers Public Liability, Theft, Accidents, Injury and Accidental Death, which occur through the negligence of the Museum or any member of staff. The Museum's policy does not cover the hirer. Hirers must have their own Public Liability insurance cover.

Deposits

A 20% deposit is required to secure a booking. If a hirer wishes to cancel for whatever reason, the following charges will apply:

Less than one month – whole hire fee applies

1-3 months - 50% of hire charge is payable

3-6 months - deposit will be retained

Over 6 months - no charge payable

If the Museum has to cancel a hiring through circumstances beyond its control, no charge will be made nor any payment made in respect of any work the Hirer might have done in relation to the event.
