- Support the team in handling stock deliveries to our shop and cafe. Price and display merchandise in the Museum shop
- Clean and tidy all areas of the reception, shop and café to ensure they are presentable to visitors

Curatorial

- Carry out fascinating research into individuals, campaigns and aircraft.
- Help preserve and maintain records of enduring value through Digitization.
- Work alongside our Curatorial team to repackage items and objects.
- Catalogue artefacts, documents and images to help tell the story of Army Aviation.
