David Short is from Northumberland and was educated at Queen Elizabeth Grammar School in Hexham, Durham and Cambridge Universities. He attended the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst, in 1983. He served for 30 years in the Army.

On promotion to Brigadier, he became the Director of Army Aviation and also held the post of Director of Development in the Joint Helicopter Command.
