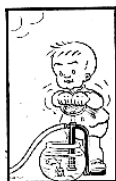

During the Second World War food was **RATIONED** to stop it running out and people were asked to plant their own **VEGETABLES** and even to keep chickens. Food such as spam and whale meat was also donated by other **ALLIED** countries to stop us from getting too hungry.

In the case of an Air **RAID** families would shelter in **ANDERSON** shelters in their gardens or in **MORRISON** shelters in their homes. Sometimes they had to use large **PUBLIC** shelters at railways stations and even in the walls of castles. Adults and children were given **GAS** masks and had to carry them with them at all times.

People put **TAPE** across their window panes to stop the glass from **SHATTERING** and also put up **BLACKOUT** curtains to stop any light escaping. This made it more difficult for **ENEMY** planes to find their **TARGETS** as there were no **LIGHTS** to give away the position of towns and cities.

A.R.P **WARDENS** checked to make sure everyone was alright in the community and parents were encouraged to evacuate their children to the safety of the **COUNTRYSIDE**
